Thank you for taking time to read about our organization and the progress we have made in the last year. For the year 2018, we added a first grade class and two new teachers, Hellen and Purity. Hellen is out current first grade teacher and Purity is teaching the preschoolers.

Majority of our students are orphans. Previously, we were only a pre-school and our students would transfer to a neighboring elementary school.

Those students from our program have been the top students at that school. This is a great testament to the wonderful and hard work our teachers have been doing in establishing our students with a strong educational foundation.

We are hoping to add a new class each year so that our students don't have to transfer schools.

Other major accomplishments:

- \* Completed the internal and external finishings for preschool and grade 1 classrooms.
- \* Installed electricity
- \* Installed floor tiles, thereby reduced the amount of dust in the classroom and created a conducive teaching and learning environment.

## Goals for 2018-2019

- \* Finishing the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade classroom construction.
- \* Ensuring teachers are paid monthly
- \* Replacing all broken chairs.
- \* Reintroduce the feeding program.
